Matters to Confirm before Fitting the Product (matters which, if neconfirm before Fitting the Product or property damage)

(matters which, if neglected, can cause physical

- The Product can be fitted to any of the three types of doors shown at right.
- Use the Product within the prescribed load torque range (see the table in Specifications). An excessive load torque can cause damage to the Product.

- Fit the right-hand and left-hand dampers properly (see Assembly Drawing)
- Provide a door stopper to prevent from over turning beyond the prescribed range (see Damper Effective Angle) and Application Examples)
- Make sure that the part to which the Product is fitted has sufficient strength.

• When an attempt is made to manually turn the hinge in the direction in which the damper works, the torque in the rated torque range (0 to about 60 degrees) may be so large that the hinge cannot be turned to the "Close" position (see Damper Effective Angle)).



- Put a cap to each end of the brackets after the right and left-hand dampers have been installed properly.
- Fit the Product using care that an off-center shaft does not occur. An off-center shaft can increase the load or prevent smooth
- Be sure to install not to occur an off-center shaft. For installation at decline position please contact our customer service.




WARNING (matters which, if neglected, can cause physical or property damage)



Do not force the door to close faster in damper effective direction. It can cause damage to the Product



- When the door opening angle is small, the dampers may not work smoothly.
- The damper characteristic is affected at room temperature, but this is not mechanical problem.



Screws not included.

Recommended screws and washers: M5 hexagon socket head screw × 8, washer 5 mm in nominal diameter × 8 (for two dampers)



Installation Procedure

- 1. Confirm the damper type, and then fit the damper body (stainless steel) into the body bracket and the shaft (plastic) into the shaft bracket (see Details of Parts and Assembly Drawing).
- 2. Confirm the right-hand and left-hand dampers and fit the hinges assembled in Step 1 to the cabinet (see Assembly Drawing).
- 3. Turn the hinges to any angle in the low torque range (about 60 to 115 degrees) and fit the door to the cabinet (see Damper Effective Angle)
- 4. Put the caps onto both sides of the bracket tightly.
- 5. Open and close the door repeatedly to check that it moves smoothly.







Even when the hinge is manually turned within the rated torque range (0 to about 60 degrees), it automatically returns to about 60 degrees when it is released. Fit the door at an angle at which the dampers do not automatically return (low

torque range-about 60 to 115 degrees) even when it is released. (see Damper Effective Angle))
